Founded in 1921, Ukrainian Medical Stomatological Academy (UMSA) is one of the oldest universities of Ukraine, training doctors, dentists, nurses and other medical professionals. Nowadays, it is the leading Ukrainian University with extensive clinical bases and strong scientific potential.

Academy Structure

Clinical Work

- Treatment and consultancy is carried out in 38 clinical departments of the Academy at 34 medical establishments of Poltava.
- Clinical capacity is 5527 beds and 430 dental chairs.
- At the clinical sites, the 398 staff include:

- Training diagnostic medical pulmonology centre;
- Regional scientific and practical centre for diseases of the oral mucosa;
- Training and advisory diabetes centre;
- Scientific-methodical laboratory for training dentists;
- Educational and scientific-practical centre for interventional radiology.
- The Academy also includes "The Dental Centre" as an educational, scientific and medical structural division with departments for therapeutic dentistry, dental surgery, prosthetic dentistry and orthodontics.



The Academy is renowned for its research activities in Ukraine and abroad

- UMSA conducts training in clinical internship and residency, PhD courses and doctoral studies.
- The Academy also has a strong scientific division the Research Institute for Genetics and Immunological Foundations of Pathology and Pharmacogenetics - whose staff scientists are constantly engaged in research and innovation projects.
- There are currently 63 initiative research projects in progress at the Academy.




In 2016-2017 academic year, cooperation with OSCE observer Anthony Robinson from the UK has been arranged and conducted.

In 2016, the Academy signed an agreement on academic mobility with Aristotle University (Thessaloniki, Greece) in the framework of "Erasmus Mundus" programme


